Subject: Construction Update - New Nursing and Allied Health Building

All,

The general contractor now has everything in place to start the project. The first portion of their work will involve the demolition of the two catwalks on the south side of the VTI Building and excavation of material from the terraced area that leads to the basement of the VTI Building. This work should start this week, possibly as early as tomorrow. In days to come, the contractor will also create a new (but temporary) emergency exit for the west wing of the VTI Building as well as make some modifications to the existing entry lobbies of the VTI Building at the entrances that are affected by the demolition.

Also, Louisville Paving finished their final layer of asphalt on the new parking area on the north side of the VTI Building this afternoon. I did not speak to their supervisor before he left today, but I would expect that the new parking that is being created on the north side of the building will be available for use later this week. I'll update you when I get a definite answer.

We are schedule to have meetings with the general contractor every other Friday. Our next meeting is scheduled for Friday June 13th. I'll send a further update after that meeting .
